

Using iPhoto and Safari to gather and organize pictures

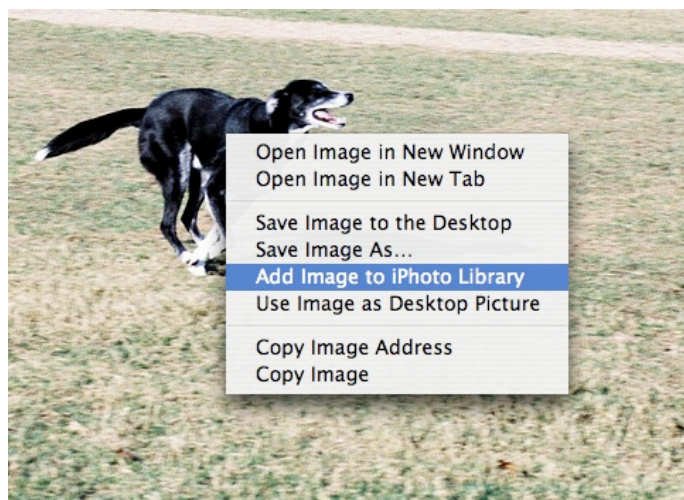
1. Launch iPhoto
2. Launch Safari
3. Go to <http://www.flickr.com/search/advanced/>
4. Check this box



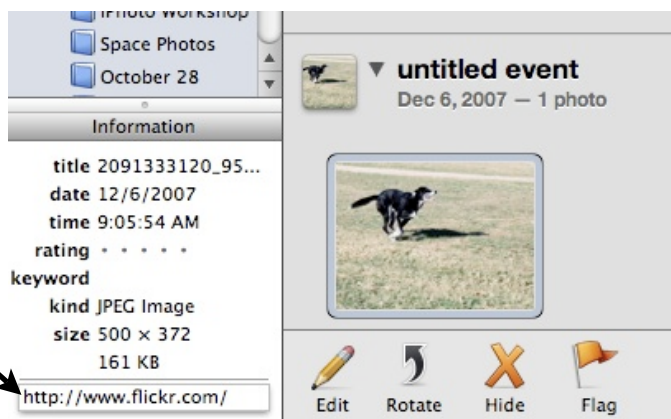

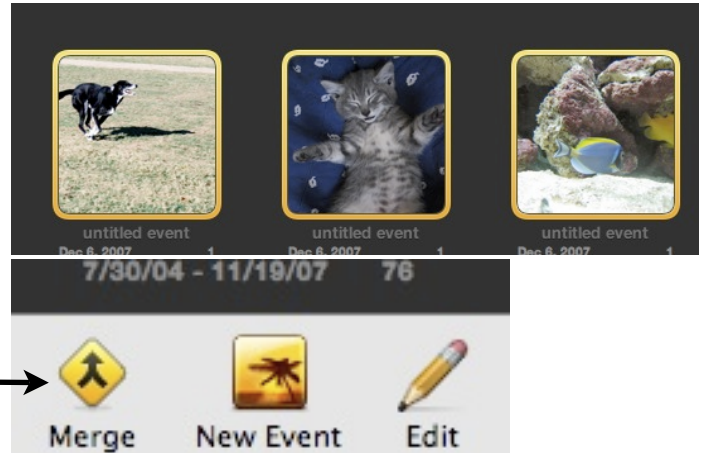
5. Search for your photos
6. Ctrl + click the picture you want and choose “Add Image to iPhoto Library” from the drop-down menu.



7. Copy the URL that you got the photo from and paste it into the description section for the picture.



8. Repeat this process for all of your pictures.
9. *Hint* You can use Cmd + Tab to quickly switch between applications, or F9.
10. In iPhoto, choose *Events* in the upper left corner.
11. Hold down the Command key, and single-click each picture you added.



12. Click the *Merge* button to merge the events together into one event.
13. Give your event a name.
